



The Canadian Fallen Firefighters Foundation was incorporated in 2003 as a registered, non-profit, charitable organization made up of members of the Canadian Fire Service and other interested citizens dedicated to honouring Canada's fallen firefighters.

Although many provinces and municipalities have paid homage to the firefighters who have died in the line of duty, there has never been a Canadian Firefighters Memorial. One of the Foundation's major goals is the construction of the Canadian Firefighters Memorial. A design competition has been concluded and construction for this new national memorial will begin in 2011 on land in the LeBreton Flats area of Ottawa close to the new War Museum. It will be a place honouring all the firefighters of Canada who have died in the line of duty.

The objectives of the Foundation include:

- raising funds to build and maintain the Canadian Firefighters Memorial
- conducting the Canadian Firefighters Annual Memorial Ceremony
- providing financial assistance to the families of fallen firefighters for the annual ceremony
- providing financial assistance for educational purposes for children of fallen firefighters
